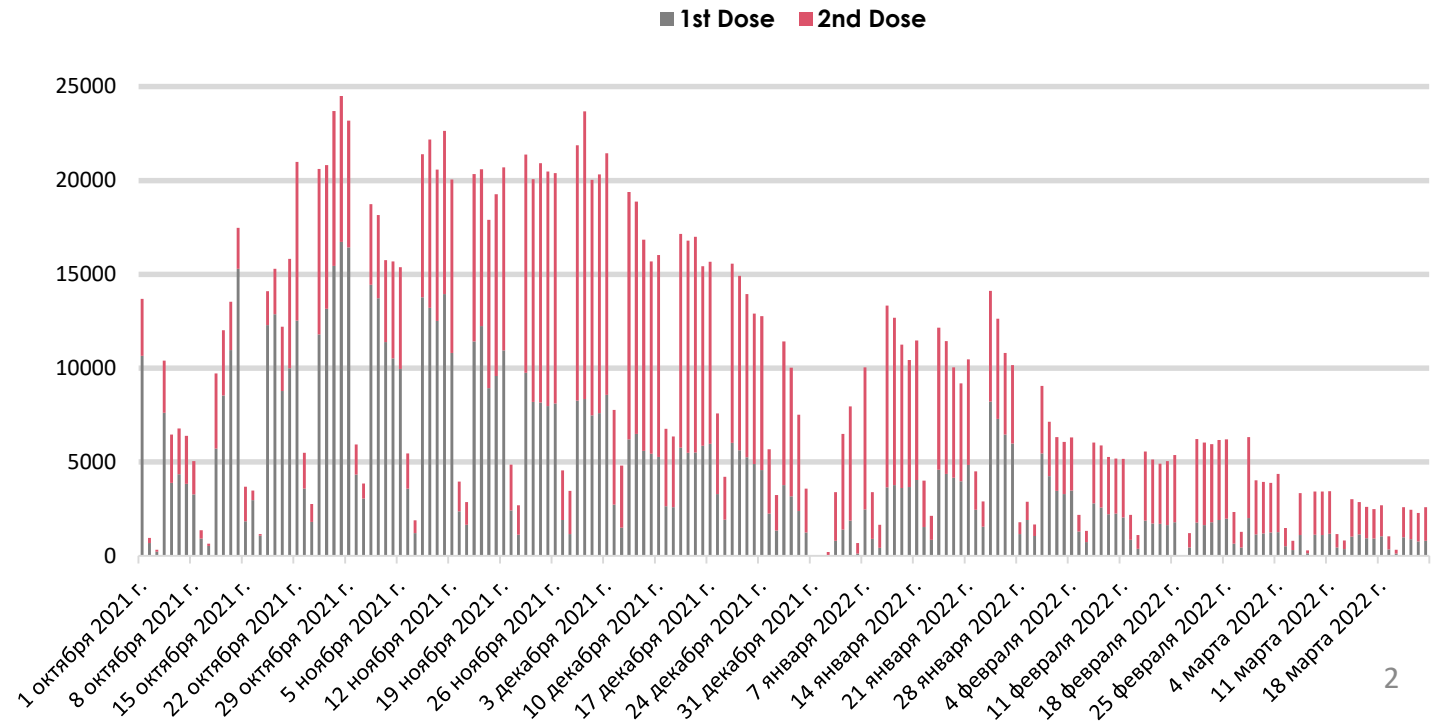

factors influencing hesitancy

Lack of public confidence in new vaccines (not enough testing, don't know long term consequences, etc.)

Misinformation, myths, **negative** news circulating about COVID-19 **vaccine safety and effectiveness**

Personal responsibility and risk perception

(KAP survey: out of 3000+ people surveyed, 70% considered themselves susceptible to contracting COVID-19, but 70% said they would not be seriously ill)

Fertility and health concerns

effective social behavior change communication

Enforcement of **policies for employers, employees, and public spaces**

Extensive risk communication material with clear messages
and information

(extensive risk comm. strategy prepared for 2022-2023)

Continuous communication activities to improve HCWs
knowledge & communication methods with patient

successes

Vaccination among HCWs is the **highest among all risk groups** with **96% of HCWs** having received two doses

Streamlining process of vaccination

New website launched with **all COVID-19 information and updates** centralized in one place for easy accessibility
