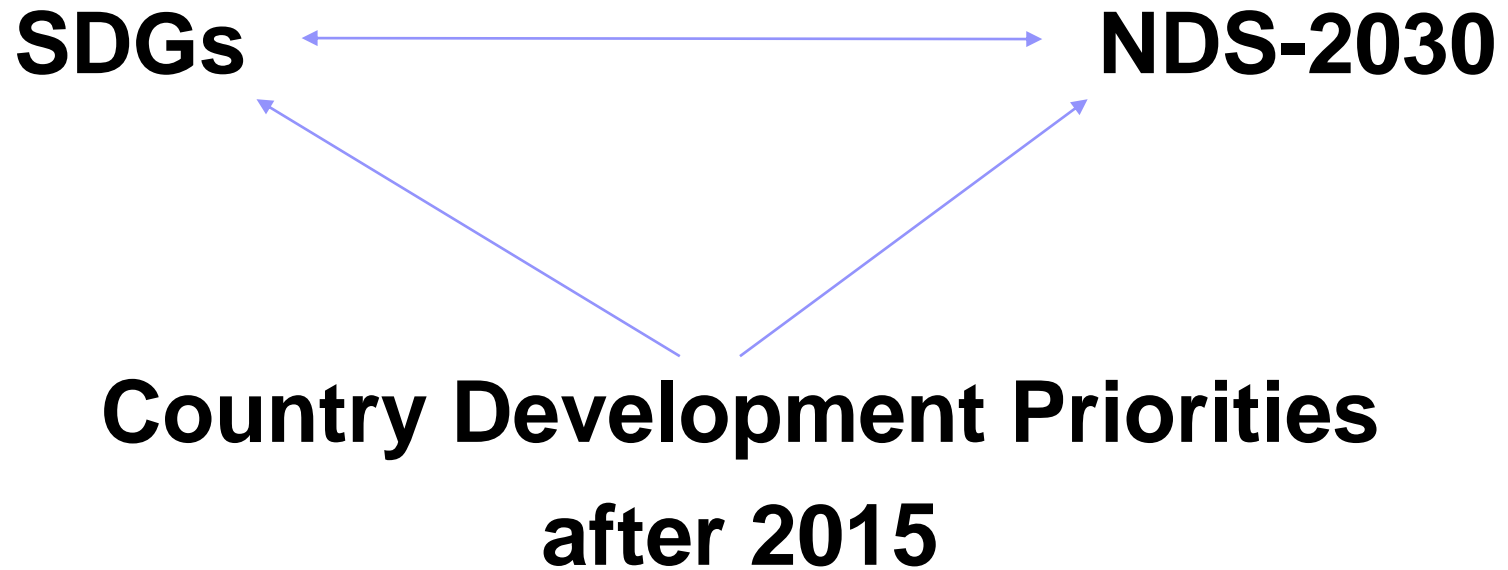
National consultations on the SDG agenda

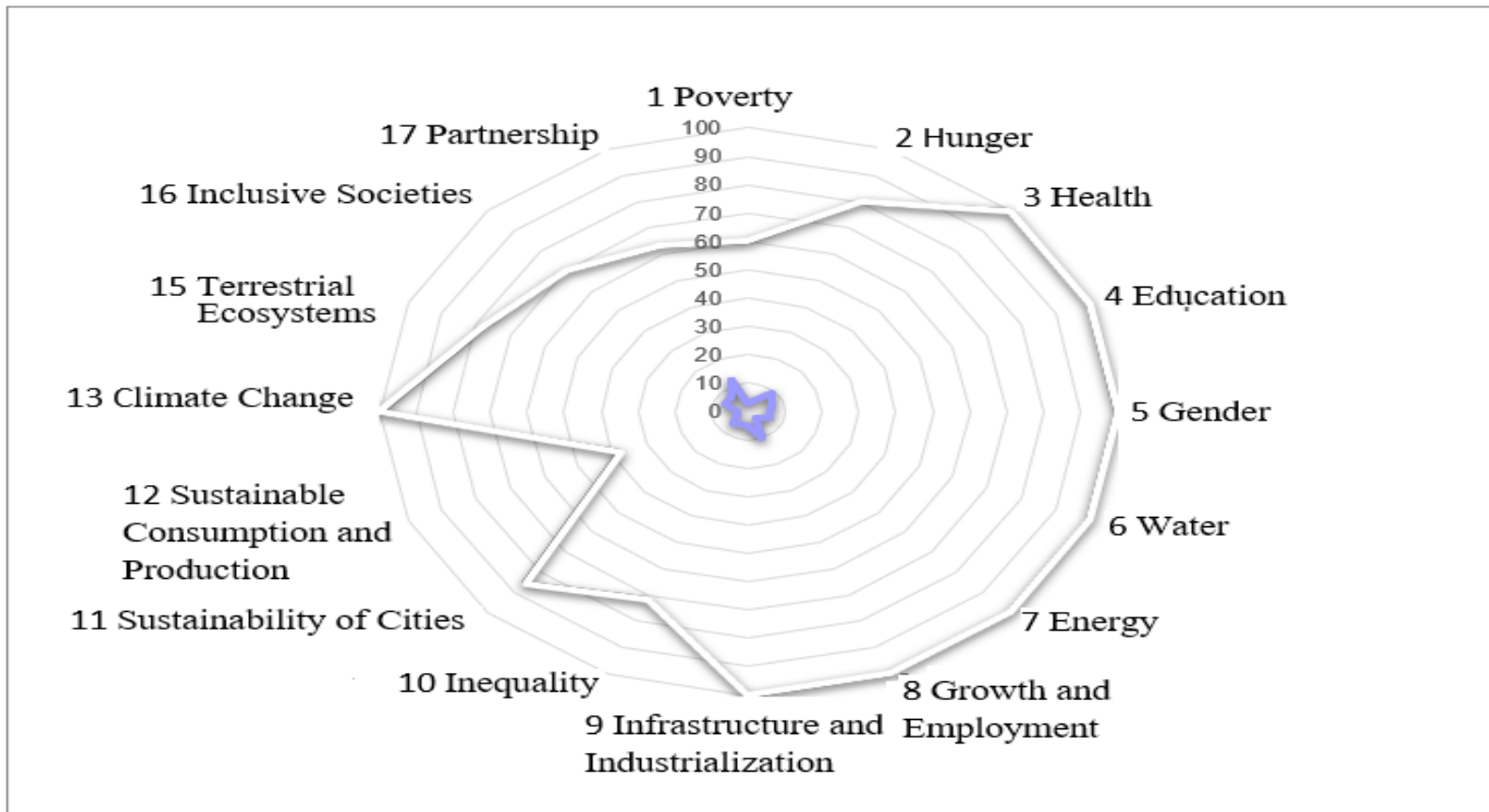
The main focus of the SDGs is the concept of sustainable human development.

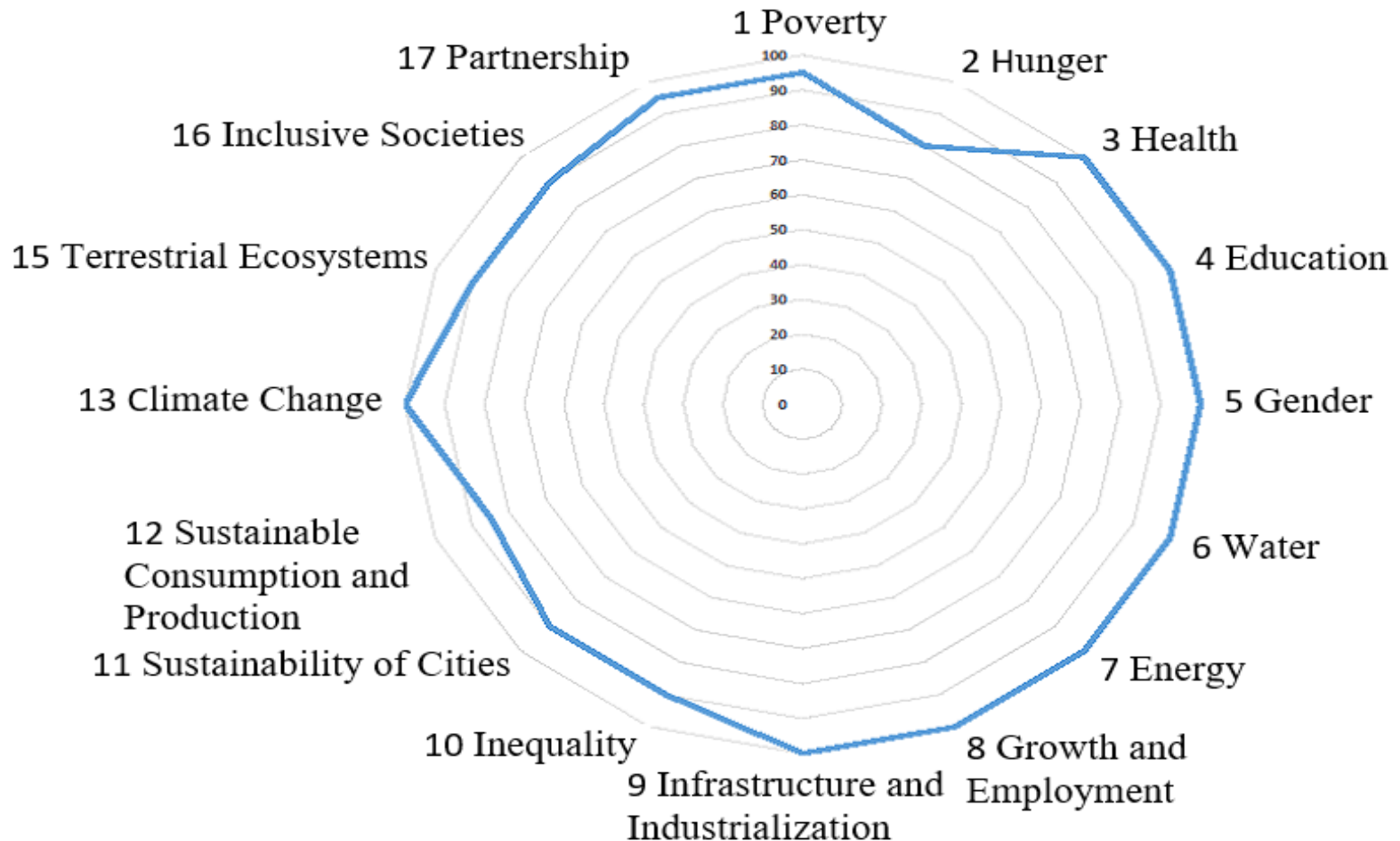
How are existing policies and strategies reflected in the SDGs?

Results of Tajikistan profiling after a review of additional sectoral and regional strategies, programs and development plans of the Republic of Tajikistan

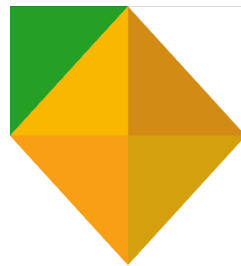

This Review is a preliminary assessment of the process of implementing the Medium-Term Development Program for the period 2016-2020. At the same time, progress is assessed not only through the prism of medium-term goals, but also long-term expectations, reflected in the National Development Strategy for the period up to 2030 and the Sustainable Development Goals

PROBLEMS:

- "Leave no one behind" - how to calculate it?
- Indicators - it is not difficult to nationalize, but how do make them unified, and cross-cutting for all regions of the Republic?
- Institutionalization of indicators – how to make them mandatory for information collection?
- Mechanism of application of indicators - how often, what is the level of sampling?
