Actuality



In Kyrgyzstan, on average, about 700 - 800 people are killed and more than 11,000 people are injured per year.

More than 2,000 children are injured and more than 100 children die each year.






Online survey among citizens of the KR (April-May 2021). The total number - 196 people.


Almost every second driver reported that he/she exceeded the speed limit.

Moskovskaya - Beyshenalieva (2 pedestrian collision in 2018)






Infrastructure upgrades:

- Replacement and installation of pedestrian and transport traffic lights (cables, poles, controller).
- Audio signal pedestrian lights for visually impaired pedestrians
- Replacement of road signs(putting additional road signs)
- Straightening of pedestrian crossings
- Repair of adjacent sidewalks, stairs, ramps
- Painting of pedestrian crossings/road marks
- Installation of additional lighting
- Putting a safety island on Moskovskaya Beishenalieva
- Repair of sidewalks





Traffic lights increased from 13 lamp traffic lights to 14 LED traffic lights

Pedestrian traffic lights increased from 5 to 10 with audible signals

Road signs increased from 21 to 38

Electric lamps increased from 5 to 7

341 parents


64 teachers

Does improving the intersection near your school help you feel safer?

7 out of 10 students believe that improving the intersection near the school makes them feel safer.

Participation at the Work Group initiated by the MIA on Developing Draft of National Road Safety Strategy

 Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic dated February 6, 2023 No. 50 - approve the National Road Safety Strategy in the Kyrgyz Republic for 2023-2027. Reference to EASST, p.3:

"Research conducted by the Eastern Alliance for Safe and Sustainable Transport (EASST) in 2017 in collaboration with the road safety authority shows that the majority of fatal accidents (72) occurred at 15 intersections in the city of Bishkek»

Participation at the Work Group of Ministry of Internal Affairs jointly with the public organization "Civil Union". Based on the results of Work Group:

"Concept of state policy in the field of crime prevention for 2022-2028", "National action plan for the implementation of the Concept of state policy in the field of crime prevention for 2022-2028" were adopted. Public Association "Road safety" submitted its proposals regarding Road Safety.
