

The number of think tanks worldwide





What More Can Be Done for Collective Action?

From the reports of Global Go To Think Tank Index, on think tanks-TTT report, CAREC, and other organizations, it is evident that there is a significant number of think tanks operating on environmental and climate change issues at both the global and national levels.

However, the extent to which these think tanks influence policy-making processes remains a subject that requires further investigation.

At this point, I believe we should focus on the following issues:

The first issue, in my opinion, is the financial sustainability of the relevant think tank organizations. Naturally, if these organizations do not have sufficient and sustainable financial resources, their output and impact will be limited.

The second issue is the need for a continuous, yet distanced and sustainable relationship between the relevant think tanks and government institutions. Otherwise, it cannot be expected that the knowledge produced will be taken into account by governments. In this dialogue, official intergovernmental structures like CAREC play important roles.

Another point is the necessity of experience-sharing and collaboration with non-regional think tanks that have significant experience in this field globally. I believe that CAREC has the necessary infrastructure and resources to facilitate this.
